## Passports, Visas And Health Requirements

#### \* United States:

British Citizens travelling to the United States of America (US) require a full machine readable e-passport which must be valid for the full duration of your stay, however we recommend a validity of at least 6 months after departure from this country. All members of your party must have their own passport.

Most British citizens are eligible for the Visa Waiver Programme, which allows travel to the US for up to 90 days. It is essential that you obtain an electronic travel authorisation (known as ESTA) before boarding your flight to the US. Please apply here: <u>US ESTA application</u>. The current fee is USD14 and authorisation is normally granted immediately but may take up to 72 hours. You must hold a return or onward ticket. If traveling on an electronic ticket, a copy of the itinerary must be carried for presentation to U.S. immigration at the port of entry. Unless you are transitting the US within 8 hours you will be required to provide a valid US address to the airline at check-in or prior to departure. This must include the Street name, City, State, and Zip Code for your first night in the US. If you travel from the US to Canada, Mexico and the Caribbean you can usually re-enter using the ESTA and admission stamp you were issued when you first arrived in the US, although the time you spend outside of the country is included in the 90 days allotted for your visit. Make sure you're clear about the length of time the immigration officer has authorised you to remain in the US if you re-enter under the same ESTA. Please check up to date visa requirements with the Foreign Office.

You should contact your preferred travel health professional for advice well in advance of your holiday. A full summary of health advice can be found via the foreign office site as well as the National Travel Health Network and Centre (NaTHNaC) set up by the Department of Health. #### \* Canada:

British Citizens travelling to Canada require a full passport which must be valid for 6 months after departure from this country. All members of your party must have their own passport.

British citizens do not usually need a visa to visit Canada but you must obtain an "electronic Travel Authorization" (eTA) prior to travel. We recommend you do this at least 72 hours prior to travel as you cannot board your flight without one. This will be electronically linked to your passport, which means you will need to travel with the same passport you used when you applied for and obtained your eTA. Please follow this link to apply for your eTA <u>Online eTA application</u>

Please check up to date visa requirements with the Foreign Office.

If you are travelling via the USA even if just in transit (changing aircraft) or for a day trip, will be required to obtain a US electronic travel authoristation (known as ESTA) before you begin your journey from the UK. This also includes all customers travelling to Alaska on a cruise. Please apply here: <u>US ESTA application</u>. Authorisation is normally granted immediately but may take up to 72 hours.

To qualify to rent the Dollar vehicle, the renter must present at the time of rental a valid driver's license and valid major credit card or debit card (see Debit Card Usage below) in the renter's own name with available credit. At the time of rental, an authorized hold will be secured on your credit/debit card provided to cover the estimated rental charges and any additional charges that may be incurred. These funds will not be available for your use. We will place an authorization amount of up to \$350 or 15% of the estimated rental charges, depending on rental location and card used. If Dollar cannot secure credit approval for this amount and/or proper identification credentials are not supplied, Dollar will decline your rental. At many locations, debit cards issued under a VISA, MasterCard and Discover logo which draw funds directly from the cardholder's account may be used at the outset of a rental to qualify for a rental where the following requirements are met; at Dollar Airport locations, you will be required to provide proof of a return airline flight to coincide with the rental and present two (2) valid forms of identification; and at Dollar Off Airport locations, you need to be at least 25 years old, present two (2) valid forms of identification and one of the following: (a) provide a Corporate Discount Plan (CDP) number or (b) proof of a return travel ticket to coincide with the rental (airline or cruise). However, there are exceptions to this Dollar Off Airport location policy; Debit cards are not accepted at the outset of a rental to qualify for rentals in the Off Airport locations in New York Metropolitan Tri-State Area (NY, NJ, CT), areas of Hartford, CT, areas of Philadelphia, PA, areas of Boston, MA, areas of Manchester, NH, areas of Detroit, MI and areas of Baltimore, MD. There are exceptions to this general policy: Debit Cards are accepted for Dollar EXPRESS members when the card is already in the member's profile or the rental is a Replacement rental. Debit cards are accepted for payment at the end of your rental. In most cases, the location will perform a credit check for debit card customers to determine credit worthiness at the time of rental. The customer must meet the minimum criteria to rent using a debit card. Cash rentals which require an up-front deposit of cash are accepted from customers who have obtained a Cash Deposit Identification (ID) Card. Applications for a Cash Deposit ID Card are available from Dollar.com. Debit card and prepaid or store value cards are accepted for payment at the end of your rental.

At time of rental, customers paying with VISA at ALL locations will have 15% of their estimated total added as an incidental amount. This receipt of paper will expire in 30 days, the receipt is dated and the location will run the Florida driver's license through the DMV. The location will accept the receipt as a valid driver's license.

When the renter chooses to receive Frequent Flyer miles, we will collect a Frequent Flyer surcharge, not to exceed \$1.50 per day, at the time of rental to offset a portion of the annual cost of participation in the Frequent Flyer program.

Reservations will be honored for 6 hours after original scheduled pick up time. Customers with reservations who experience weather or mechanical delays with airlines will be accommodated.

A shuttle will take you to the Port of Miami.

Dollar/Thrifty is located at both Terminal A and Terminal B at MCO Airport. The Rental Counter is located in terminal. Vehicles are stored on site. Customers will walk to the vehicles.
